- OCulture is "a pattern of thinking, feeling, and reacting to various situations and actions." Kluckhohn and Kroeber (anthropologist)

What is Culture?

- OCulture is the shared understandings people use within a society to align their actions. Becker (sociologist)
- OCulture represents the way a group of people organize their ideas and hence their lives i.e. cultural artifacts, cultural values and assumptions. Livermore (international educator)



Vancity Report

- O 82% of all respondents who identify as a members of a visible minority group experienced some form of discrimination or racism
 - 57% say the believe people make assumptions about them because of their ethnic background
 - O46% feel they face social disadvantages because of their ethnic background
 - O33% say they have been a target of abuse because of their ethnic background
 - 11% say the experience of discrimination had been traumatic enough to make them consider moving
